## PT Challenge

## WATERFRONT PARK

Waterfront Park is conveniently located along Lake Minneola, nestled between East Avenue and Eighth Street. Passing through the park is "Rails to Trails", a paved trail used by walkers, bikers, and rollerbladers alike. There are restroom facilities, picnic areas, beach front swim area and fishing piers. Also, there is plenty of Florida wildlife to be viewed. "The Great Florida Triathlon" is held here along with the annual "Pig on the Pond" event and a variety of other activities throughout the year. The annual parking passes are available at city hall for \$25.00 per year or \$2.00 per day. There is currently no swimming at Waterfront Park, however the park is open. The playground is open for use.

## Emergency Preparedness

Residents are always encouraged to be prepared during hurricane season by updating their family's disaster plan and restocking their family disaster kit.

Disaster supplies should include: Bottled water, non-perishable food items, manual can opener, flashlight and batteries, battery-operated radio, one month's supply of medication, basic toiletries, blankets, pillows, water-proof bag of important documents and a first aid kit.

As a reminder, remember that you should include your pets in your evacuation plans should the need arise due to Fire, Hurricane, Tornado or other disaster. All medical records, registrations, tags and photo ID should be included in your evacuation kits. Along with their medications, kennel/carrier, food, water, leash, collar litter box and litter and some of their toys which can ease their stress. Know where the Pet Friendly Shelters are and remember they will not let your pets in, unless you can provide proof of all vaccinations.

The shelters listed will be opened whenever there is a voluntary or mandatory evacuation ordered. They will be staffed by Lake County Animal Services Personnel. If you have any questions, the telephone number is **352-343-9688**.

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security promotes individual emergency preparedness through the national 'Ready' campaign. Emergency officials are encouraging residents to actively prepare for emergencies. The campaign asks individuals to do the following:

Stockpile a disaster supply kit  
Develop a family emergency plan

Be informed about all the different types of emergencies that could occur in your community
